

## USE OF MOFGA CERTIFIED ORGANIC LOGO



The usage of the MOFGA certification logo and the statement “Certified Organic by MOFGA” are protected by trademark.

Any grower or processor who is certified by MOFGA Certification Services, LLC, is entitled to use the “USDA Organic” logo and the MOFGA Certified Organic logo, as per Sections 205.303-311 of the NOP Rule.

If you elect to use the MOFGA Certified Organic logo, you must maintain a current membership with the Maine Organic Farmers and Gardeners Association (or pay an equivalent fee on an annual basis\*). Permission to use the logo may be withdrawn if membership is not maintained by the individual(s) or business entity that appears on the Organic Producer’s Endorsement. In addition, permission to use the logo may be withdrawn in the event that MOFGA Certification Services LLC issues a Notice of Suspension or Revocation of Certification, as per Section 205.662 (e).

The MOFGA Certification Services logo for use on certified organic products is shown above, please be aware that this logo is different than the MOFGA logo.
